



Multiple output schemes



Catchment management for slow clean raw water supplies can also be targeted to deliver these additional outcomes:

- flood risk reduction,
- reduction of catchment flow sources in to urban areas
- reduction of CSO discharge risks
- catchment nutrient loading reduction
- reduced nutrient and sediment loading into bathing waters
- carbon storage
- catchment base flows

New areas and catchments for this approach in 2020 business plan: Roadford, Stitians, Wistlandpound, Burrator, Park and Stannon, River Axe
